To this day, 7 districts have been targeted by this initiative "des territoires d'inclusion prioritaires" (Priority Inclusion Initiative or TIP) in Montréal and recently, three new districts have been added. In the interest of continuing this project, "Cuisine ton Quartier" is branching out in Winnipeg and in Sudbury to help others understand and bring the challenges of Francophone immigrants to light.
